The Cleveland Orchestra Chorus (COC) is offering fellowships for undergraduate and graduate students pursuing a degree in a music-related field during the 2024-2025 academic year. Up to three **Shari Bierman Singer Fellowships** may be granted, each in the amount of \$3,500. Students must have demonstrable skill, evidenced through a combination of academic and musical talent, GPA, and performance ability. Applicants must be able to commit to the full rehearsal and performance schedule of The Cleveland Orchestra Chorus. Fellowship recipients will have additional guidance and mentorship opportunities from the staff of The Cleveland Orchestra.

FLIGIBILITY

- College undergraduate and graduate level students pursuing a vocal performance, music education, conducting, or similar music-related degree during the 2024-2025 academic year.
- Students must be enrolled full-time.
- Students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Students must be able to commit to the full rehearsal and performance schedule of the COC.

- One letter of reference supporting musical background and character from current or most recent studio/private director or ensemble director
- A personal statement about how your participation as a chorus member would contribute to your longterm goals (not to exceed 500 words)
- A copy of your most recent transcript (an unofficial transcript is acceptable).

Auditions will be heard by appointment on **Saturday, April 20** at University Circle United Methodist Church, 1919 E 107th St, in Cleveland. Upon completion of the online application, candidates receive the link to schedule an audition appointment.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Perform two contrasting pieces, each approximately 3 minutes in duration. At least one selection should be in French, German, or Italian.
- Sight-read selections of the director's choice, with accompaniment.
- Sing scales, arpeggios, or other technical exercises as directed.

CHORUS SCHEDULE The Cleveland Orchestra Chorus rehearses on Monday evenings from 7:00pm – 10:00pm in University Circle, with some additional Sunday evenings and every night during concert weeks. Fellows will attend rehearsals beginning September 3, 2024, and ending May 25, 2025. A detailed schedule is available at www.cochorus.com.

Members of the COC perform with The Cleveland Orchestra in subscription and Christmas concerts. Season highlights include Mahler's Third Symphony, conducted by Klaus Mäkelä; the world premiere of a newly commissioned work by Bernd Richard Deutsch; *Oltra Mar* (Saariaho) and Orchestral Set No. 2 by Ives conducted by Thomas Adès; J.S. Bach's *Magnificat*, conducted by Bernard Labadie; Janáček's *Jenůfa*; and J.S. Bach's *Komm, Jesu, Komm.*
